



Reflectors for mobile protection systems:

The Beilharz reflectors make an important contribution for a better visibility of mobile protection systems and thus for more safety on the road. By the attachment of the reflectors at the mobile protection system, e.g. a concrete wall, the visibility is increased, an additional guideline is created and thereby the risk of accidents is minimized clearly.

The reflectors for mobile protection systems are available for screwing on as well as for gluing on. Both variants are available in yellow or white. Of course the reflector is proofed by German Road Administration (BAST).

<p>Reflector in yellow:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Reflector for mobile protection systems • Yellow case in the dimension 130 x 22mm • Yellow reflector one-sided or both-sided in the dimension 120 x 18mm • Reflector BAST-proofed • Available for screwing or gluing on (with butyl tape strip) • Hole diameter 5,5mm 	
<p>Reflector in white</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Reflector for mobile protection systems • White case in the dimension 130 x 22mm • White reflector one-sided or both-sided in the dimension 120 x 18mm • Reflector BAST-proofed • Available for screwing or gluing on (with butyl tape strip) • Hole diameter 5,5mm 	

The execution to glue on has a flexible glue material on the lower surface of the case (butyl tape strip). Directly before applying at the mobile protection system the protection strip has to be removed and reflector is applied by pressing on.

The execution to screw on is fastened by screws or pins to the concrete wall (the equipment for applying is not contained in the scope of supply).

Both executions are equipped with the drilling holes in the case shown in the figure above.
